

And what are the gifts you don't share, the second coat you don't give away, the despair you try to sell, overpriced? Let God gently take them from your hands.





#### FCCF Council Meeting Minutes December 12, 2018

The Minutes from the November 14 meeting were reviewed. With no corrections noted, the Minutes were approved as presented.

**Treasurer's Report:** Dinah Haag for Andy Mollema
1. Offerings for November: \$ 9,621.00
2. Expenses for November: \$12,475.63
3. Carryover for November: -\$ 1,209.02

There were a couple of items of note: 1) Concerning Pastor Dinah's retirement - 3/4 of the Account has been funded; 1/4 will be added in December; and 2) Pastor Dinah will print out the 2018 disbursement totals from the Baird Funds and email to Council members. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

#### **Committee Reports**

**Finance:** Judy Welch - See Treasurer's Report

<u>Missions</u>: Andy Mollema - This account remains fully funded.

**Nominating:** Myra Elias - The new Slate of Council members for 2019 has been approved.

<u>Outreach</u>: Myra Elias - 1) Caroling at our long term facilities and the Gathering afterward at Hirschfeld's is scheduled for December 19; 2) The movie "Peter Rabbit" will be shown at the Garden Theater on December 29 courtesy of FCCF; and 3) Myra Elias suggested that, beginning in the new year, we focus again on visiting those who live alone or cannot make it to church services.

<u>Property</u>: Andrea Frost - 1) The first air conditioning unit has been installed in the Sanctuary with the second to be installed the week after next; 2) Pastor Dinah gave the committee a review of our church's insurance policy from Church Mutual; and 3) The carpets have been cleaned.

Women's Fellowship: Mary Reed - 1) The Silver Tea was a big success with proceeds totaling \$1,308.15, less \$124.00 for change; 2) A \$50.00 Christmas gift was sent to 12 college students; and 3) Our CD account totals \$3,118.69 with interest accrued of \$7.14.

Worship: Ann Osborn - Upcoming events include: 1) The children's Christmas Pageant during service on December 16; 2) The Christmas Eve Candlelight Service and Communion on December 24; 3) Hymn Sing Sunday on December 30; and 4) Taking down of Sanctuary Advent decorations on January 3. Pastor Dinah will be on vacation from December 30 after church service until January 8 and Rosemary Abbett will be on vacation from December 26 to January 5. Pastor Dinah is also in the midst of revamping the Praise Book and looking for any suggestions for songs/hymns.

<u>Historian</u>: Al Bryant - Al will return as our church historian.

Pastor's Report: Dinah Haag - Report submitted

<u>Unfinished Business</u>: There will be an offering taken during the Christmas Eve Service with monies given to be used for the ongoing mission of the church.


