FCCF Council Meeting Minutes December 11, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 pm by Council Chair, Myra Elias, followed by the Opening Prayer. The Minutes from the November 13 meeting were reviewed. With no corrections noted, the Minutes were approved as presented.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Andy Mollema

1. Offerings for Nov. totaled: \$9,336.00

2. Budgeted expenses for Nov. totaled: \$7,560.25

3. Carryover YTD: \$5,926.68

<u>Memorials</u>: Judy Welch - There were none for the month of November.

Finance: Judy Welch - See Treasurer's Report

Investment: Andrea Frost - As of December 11, the Baird Fund totals are: \$416,451.45 in Stocks; \$260,099.06 in Bonds with the total in our Baird Fund Account: \$676,550.51.

<u>Missions</u>: Paul Osborn - This account remains fully funded.

<u>Nominating</u>: Myra Elias - A full slate has been nominated with Luanne Elwell finishing Rob Burch's 2 year term, Larry Neuhardt continuing for a 3 year term, and two new members to Council for 3 year terms: Hugh Hessler and Jim MacKenzie.

<u>Outreach</u>: Myra Elias - No report, but there was the cookie decorating with dinner preceding held on December 5; four residents from Orchard Lane joined the festivities.

<u>Property</u>: Myra Elias - Future projects include: 1) Improvements to the front entry, including wallpaper removal and furnace fan repair, 2) Church pantry floor needs repair/replacement, 3) Storms for the stained glass windows to be revisited, 4) Relocation for the metal media shelf in the Parlor, 5) Re-caulk the trash area off the dining room in the spring, and 6) Parsonage projects (carpets have been cleaned).
