<u>Missions</u>: Myra Elias - 1) The balance in this account is \$984.51; 2) The Missions Committee is planning a meeting with the date still to be determined.

Nominating: Larry Neuhardt - 1) Council members received the new Slate of Officers list; 2) one addition since December's meeting is Rob Burch for a three-year term.

<u>Outreach</u>: Andy Mollema - 1) The Committee reviewed December's "events"; 2) There will be a Gathering 2.0 for younger adults and children to be held on January 20 at the Kolehmainen's home; and 3) Leslie McElduff will be hosting the next regular Gathering on February 2.

Religious Education: Bill Hirschfeld - 1) Al's Academy on the subject of the House of David will be held on January 17; and 2) Bill's Bible Studies on the Parables will be held on February 21 and 28.


