

## FCCF COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES January 12, 2022

The Minutes from the December 8, 2021, meeting were reviewed and with no corrections noted, were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Rob Burch

Offerings for December totaled: \$ 9,355.33 Expenses for December totaled: 12,821.91 YTD Carryover: 6,118.08

Following some discussion and review, a motion was made by Myra Elias that the Treasurer use the same approach for withdrawing the 5% from the restricted Baird Funds as was done in 2021; that is, a monthly draw based on the 2022 Budge. Judy Welch seconded the motion. Motion unanimously passed. Rob stated that the Church's budget is in good shape as we enter the new year. The Treasurer's Report was then accepted as presented.

#### **Committee Reports**

Finance: Judy Welch – see Treasurer's Report

<u>Investment</u>: Chris Porter – the total of all Baird Accounts, as of December 31, 2021, is \$856,378.57. Just a note of caution from Chris: the increase in value experienced over the past should not be expected to continue. Spending from this fund (restricted) in excess of 5% will likely erode the ability to maintain pace with inflation.

Outreach: Kelly Ottinger – 1) Al's Academy is returning in January, February, and March with the first of these scheduled for Thursday, January 20 at 5:30 pm with a light dinner preceding the presentation; 2) Coffee withOut Dinah is continuing with Judy Grant facilitating each Tuesday at 2 pm through March; 3) Sunshine calls continue to connect with those who are homebound; 4) The advertising budget remains the same for the Benzie County Patriot and the Benzie Current; and 5) Those potential new members wishing to join the church are asked to be patient until Sunday services can be held totally in person.

**Property**: Myra Elias – The following is an update on the Parsonage work: 1) Natalie from Huron Electric has completed the electrical repairs; 2) The flooring/supplies from Tilecraft have been ordered and hope to be here by March 1; 3) The plumbing issue has been repaired; 4) A kitchen cupboard was removed by Natalie with recessed lighting installed in its place; 5) The carpeting has been removed from the stairway with Steve Crouch helping to refinish and add runners; 6) Dale Herscher, with a bid of \$1800.00, will paint the interior walls with the help of Jim Buzzell; and 7) The window issue will be visited in the spring. All repairs/redos hopefully will meet the timeline and will come in under budget.

*Women's Fellowship*: Mary Reed – The Women's Fellowship gave \$50.00 Christmas gifts to each of our nine college students.

Worship: Ann Osborn – 1) The Committee met with Pastor Jim Petteys so he could meet its members; 2) There was a review of all December events; 3) Members of the now disbanded Ad Hoc Reopening Committee contacted the Worship Committee to recommend that masks be highly recommended for all attending church services during the Covid surge right now. The Committee agreed and brought it to Council who also agreed. Signage was made by Katherine and a notice will go into Sunday's bulletin as well; and 4) Upcoming events include: office hours for Pastor Petteys continue from 10 am – 12 noon on Wednesdays, the Congregational Meeting and Potluck is scheduled for January 23, Council Commissioning will be on January 30 during the service; and the next Communion Sunday is February 6.

<u>Pastor's Report</u>: Pastor Petteys informed Council that he has been very pleased and feels all is going well thus far.

<u>No Reports:</u> Memorials, Finance, Constitution & By-Laws, Missions, Nominating, Personnel, Religious Education, Unfinished Business, and New Business.

Council Chair, Myra Elias, called for the meeting's adjournment at 4:38 pm.


