When I was in college, I had the fortune to spend a year living in Denmark attending school and traveling. One of my very favorite days ever was the day I spent on a Swiss Alp walking the snow blown trails, six feet of snow on the right side of the path and 5 feet on the left. The sky was never bluer, the trees were ginomous tall, and every so often, a skier would zoom past me. I spread out my rain poncho so I could sit on it, played a little recorder I carried with me and took a nap right there. I could spend hours sharing the green of the trees and white of the snow. But unless you were there with me, a little is lost to you.

It's the same thing with Holy Week. We are generally good with Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday, but Maundy Thursday and Good Friday—not so much. But unless we go through those two days, paying attention to them, a little of Easter is lost to us.

Since there is not going to be a community Good Friday service this year, it would be even more of an opportunity to spend a couple of important evenings with the church family. Both Thursday and Friday will have a respectably brief 7:30 p.m. worship service.

Not everyone can make all the services, and that's understandable. But if the choice is between going to church and watching Jeopardy, well, I guess you will know what I would suggest. And hey, if there is anyone left in your neighborhood, bring them along! (And yes, the Sundays between now and March 20 will be "Amazing!" 


