

A Message From Pastor Jim


Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

FCCF COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES February 9, 2022

Members present: Hugh Hessler, Bob King, Jim MacKenzie, Ann Osborn, Chris Porter, Kris Richards, Linda Schweyer, Betty Webb, Judy Welch, with a welcome to our new Council members Sonia, Bob, Beth and Betty. By Zoom: Sonia Duffy & Beth McNamara, and Rob Burch. Also visiting today: Ed Schindler from RW Baird, former Council Chair Myra Elias, and our interim pastor, Rev. Jim Petteys.

The meeting was called to order by Council Chair, Linda Schweyer, at 4:00 p.m. followed by the Opening Prayer.

The Minutes from the January 12 Council Meeting and the January 23 Annual Meeting were reviewed and with no corrections noted, were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Rob Burch

Offerings January totaled:	\$ 9,430.00
Expenses for January totaled:	11,487.29
YTD Carryover:	-1,914.83

A note from Rob regarding State Savings Bank fees: 1) There is a fee for direct deposit of \$200/per year which impacts the church's payroll; and 2) There is a transaction fee added beyond 100 items per month, per account which would probably not impact us. The church will absorb these bank fees. Rob also stated that all is well with the budget at this time but to keep an eye on the fluctuating market. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

Committee Reports

<u>Finance</u>: Judy Welch – see Treasurer's Report

Investment: Chris Porter – the total of all Baird accounts, as of January 31, 2022 is: \$786,975.46.

<u>Missions</u>: Hugh Hessler—This account remains fully funded.

Property: Myra Elias, who is supervising the Parsonage redo, gave the following update: 1) The painting is

almost finished; 2) The flooring is in and waiting for pickup as soon as the painting is completed; 3) Cody Lamerson has replaced Steve Crouch (due to health reasons) and will continue rebuilding steps, replacing trim, caulking, etc.; and 4) A "shout out" to Kris Richards and Jim Buzzell who have volunteered their time to help with the painting. The project is coming in under budget and on time.

Women's Fellowship: A Council member is needed to replace Mary Reed for reporting.

<u>Worship</u>: Ann Osborn – 1) The mask update continues at least until the end of February; 2) Office hours continue for Rev. Petteys from 10 a.m. - 12 noon every Wednesday, and 3) Wednesday, March 2 is Ash Wednesday, and we will offer a service beginning at 12 noon with Rev. Petteys presiding.

<u>Unfinished Business</u>: Parsonage update – see Property Report

<u>New Business</u>: A Council Vice-Chair is needed. Judy Welch nominated Kris Richards; Linda Schweyer seconded the motion. By acclamation of all present, the nomination of Kris was approved, and she accepted the position.

Dear Dinah & Church Members Thank you for your generous support of BACN in 2021.

For over 30 years, the work done at BACN is the legacy of what was initiated by our area churches. What begn as a means of most efficiently getting food to hungry families has grown into today's food pantry and other array of services intended to help people work toward self-reliance.

The work continues, in partnership with our churches and communities as an example of Christ's love. 
