FCCF Council Minutes July 8, 2020

The Minutes from the June 10 meeting were reviewed and with no corrections noted, were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Rob Burch

Offerings for June totaled: \$ 8,764.34 Budgeted expenses April totaled: 11,387.68 Carryover YTD: -539.37

All things considered, our budget/spending is not in too bad a shape. Council members were asked to think about the possibility of a gap as we go through the year and offerings don't increase. There were a couple of questions regarding account expenditures and profit/loss. A double check with Chris, our bookkeeper, may be needed to verify. Following discussion and explanation, the Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

Committee Reports

<u>Memorials</u>: Judy Welch – a total of \$300.00 was received in June in memory of Lyle Jackson and Andy Mollema.

Finance: see Treasurer's Report

Investment: Andrea Frost – As of July 8, Stocks: \$376,710.56; Bonds: \$263,895.66; Pohlman Estate Account: \$150,000.00; the total in the Baird Investment Fund: \$790,607.06. There has been a loss of two members from the Investment Committee; therefore, replacements are needed.

Constitution & By-Laws: Jim MacKenzie – no report

<u>Missions</u>: Paul Osborn – this account remains fully funded.

Nominating: Myra Elias for Larry Neuhardt – the motion was made by Bill Hirschfeld that Myra Elias replace Larry Neuhardt as Council Chair, with Larry taking Myra's place as Vice-Chair for the remainder of the year; Judy Welch seconded the motion. Motion unanimously passed.

<u>Outreach</u>: Kelly Ottinger – 1) The committee reviewed online services and how all has been proceeding; more and more people are joining the online services with 751 people at the June 28 service; 2) the Constant Contact email forum is on target with other churches; 3) Pastor

Dinah has several upcoming weddings and memorial services this summer; and 4) the Committee is now searching for a Chair.

<u>Personnel</u>: Myra Elias – since there has been no choir since mid-March and no choir for the foreseeable future, Pastor Dinah has asked to relinquish her salary as choir director. Following discussion, ideas, and questions, the motion was made by Bill Hirschfeld that Council approve suspending the choir director's salary until further notice; Mary Reed seconded the motion. Motion unanimously passed.

<u>Property</u>: Andrea Frost – no report with a meeting scheduled next week.

<u>Religious Education</u>: Bill Hirschfeld – Julie Hirschfeld is continuing to send our children Bible verses, prayers, and Sunday School lessons.

<u>Women's Fellowship</u>: Mary Reed - the donation monies for the Frankfort High School Graduation Party was used, in lieu of the party being canceled this year, for tote bags, towels, ice cream gift certificates, etc. for the graduates.

Worship: Ann Osborn – 1) a reminder that there is a possibility of having to close down in-person Worship; 2) Pastor Dinah's vacation is from July 23 – August 7, with Jack Harnish covering the pulpit both Sundays; and 3) upcoming events include: memorial services for Andy Mollema on July 11 and for Bob Carter on July 17, and the next Communion Sunday on August 9.

<u>Pastor's Report</u>: Dinah Haag – report submitted

<u>Unfinished Business</u>: the decision was made for the following: that the letter and ballot to be mailed to our church families calling for a Congregational Meeting on Sunday, August 15, for the purpose of approving the \$50,000.00 from the Pohlman Estate for the upcoming church improvements, is correct and satisfactory to the Council.

Myra Elias, Vice-Chair, called for the adjournment of the meeting at 4:55 pm.
